About the Academy

Students may obtain a Certificate of Attendance for the attendance of one session, or, an Intensive International Master of Laws (I.I.L.L.M.) in European Public Law, a diploma level degree, following the attendance of two sessions and the defense of a dissertation.

2018 Program Highlights

The Program is composed of two 1-week intensive teaching sessions and a one Guest Lecture on different topics. At the end of each session, students must undertake an examination, which will be in the form of an essay, marked on a pass/fail or distinction basis. The final session will be held in Sounion where students will attend the Annual Reunion of the European Group of Public Law.

Eligibility to Apply

The Academy of European Public Law is for those who seek to deepen their knowledge on the reasoning and philosophy of the different national public law systems of European countries, as well as the divergences among them, and obtain either a Certificate of Attendance in European Public Law or an Intensive International LLM (I.I.L.L.M). Applicants to both the Certificate program and the I.I.L.L.M programs should possess:

1. An **Undergraduate degree** in law, political science, European studies, international affairs, or any other related field.
2. **Proficiency in English**
3. An exceptional academic background and/or maintain promising careers.

Admissions

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

1. Completed Application form
2. Payment of non-refundable application fee of 50€ and scanned copy of receipt of payment
3. Current CV, preferably in EuroPass Format
4. Evidence of Current Studies or Current Employment in digital format (scanned copy)
5. A Letter of Recommendation (for I.I.L.L.M program only, scanned copy)
6. Cover letter for Scholarship Request (if relevant, in digital format)

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Before starting the online application, please make sure you have all the requested supporting documents ready for upload
2. Complete the online Application Form
3. Upload all supportive documents when prompted in the form and submit your application.



Fees

Fees for the Academy of European Public Law include a non-refundable **50€** application fee and the program fee of **950€** for the Certificate program and **1900€** for the I.I.L.L.M. The program fee includes:

- Participation for one or two summer sessions
- Certificate of Participation and Completion
- ECTS Diploma Supplement Upon Request
- Non-printed Course Material
- Participation at the European Group of Public Law Conference.

The **Early Bird rate** is **760€ & 1520€** respectively if students apply by **April 27, 2018**, under the condition that **at least** half of the program fee is paid by **May 18th, 2018**.

Accommodation

For students who require assistance with accommodation and transportation, the Academy of European Public Law can offer a package at the following rates:

- **1300€** per person, accommodation in a single room from Sunday 21st of August to Monday, 12th of September
- **1000€** per person, accommodation in a double room from Sunday 21st of August to Monday, 12th of September

These rates include:

- Accommodation in Athens at **Athinais Hotel** on a bed and breakfast basis from Sunday, 20th of August until Saturday, 26th of August.
- Accommodation in Sounion at **Alexander Hotel** on a half board basis from Saturday, 26th of August until Sunday, 10th of September.

The classes will be held at the EPLO premises in Athens (first week) and Sounion-Legraina (2weeks), near the bay of Cape Sounion and the Temple of Poseidon, overlooking the Aegean Sea. The last four days students will be following the works of the EGPL conference that this year will take place in Sounion premises. The EPLO premises in Sounion host the European Public Law Library, one of the largest specialized academic law libraries in Europe. Its corpora on national law cover over 50 countries worldwide.
