2019 Program Highlights

The Program is composed of two 1-week intensive teaching sessions and a one Guest Lecture on different topics. At the end of each session, students must undertake an examination, which will be in the form of an essay, marked on a pass/fail or distinction basis. The final session will be held in Sounion where students will attend the Annual Reunion of the European Group of Public Law.

Admissions

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1. Completed Application form
- 2. Payment of non-refundable application fee of 50€ and scanned copy of receipt of payment
- 3. Current CV, preferably in EuroPass Format
- 4. Evidence of Current Studies or Current Employment in digital format (scanned copy)
- 5. A Letter of Recommendation (for I.I.LL.M program only, scanned copy)
- 6. Cover letter for Scholarship Request (if relevant, in digital format)

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Before starting the online application, please make sure you have all the requested supporting documents ready for upload
- 2. Complete the online Application Form
- 3. Upload all supportive documents when prompted in the form and submit your application.



Fees

Fees for the Academy of European Public Law include a non-refundable **50**€ application fee and the program fee of **950**€ for the Certificate program and **1900**€ for the I.I.L.L.M. The program fee includes:

- •Participation for one or two summer sessions
- •Certificate of Participation and Completion
- •ECTS Diploma Supplement Upon Request
- •Non-printed Course Material
- •Participation at the European Group of Public Law Conference.

The **Early Bird rate** is **760**€ & **1520**€ respectively if students apply by **April 20, 2019**, under the condition that **at least** half of the program fee is paid by **May 17th, 2019**.
